






The closed In2 Light Hatch® has a built in lockable handle which reduces the risk of trips and helps to ensure that the hatch is fully closed after being accessed.




There is NO reduction in floor integrity after installation. The walkway or platform can be used normally once the In2 Light Hatch® is installed.




The lockable handle is released and fixed in place with a Phillips head screwdriver.
